EQUIFEST

"This Show is affiliated to **Equifest**. The **two** highest exhibits not already qualified in each affiliated class will qualify." The following classes are qualifiers (7, 9, 17a, 19, 21, 24, 25, 26, 29, 31a,b,c,, 32,33, 34, 37,38,39, 40,)

TGA

These classes are open to both coloured and solid traditional gypsy cobs. You do not need to be a current member or to have your horse registered with the TGCA in order to take part in these classes. Qualification will be awarded to the top 3 youngstock, top 3 up to 14hh and top 3 over 14h, provided the exhibit meets the traditional gypsy cob breed standard (* see stallion exception below). Ridden exhibits must be 4 years and over. Additional TOYS qualification is available to the highest placed junior rider and the highest placed ridden exhibitor eligible for the restricted category. If you qualify for TOYS and you are a current member with a registered horse, the judge will sign your qualification card in the ring. This card should be submitted along with your TOYS entries. If you qualify for TOYS but are not a member you will be handed a TGCA qualification card. You then have 21 days from the date of the show to 1) [join as a member](#) and 2) [register your horse](#) in order to compete in the FINALS classes at TOYS. Stallions (four years and over) must be licensed with the TGCA prior to the show and must display their TGCA stallion disc on their bridle when competing in order to qualify for TOYS. Whilst non licensed stallions may compete in the classes, they are not eligible for qualification. For details on how to licence your stallion, please go to the Stallion Information area on the website, or contact a member of the TGCA if you require assistance. Please also read the members' handbook, for rules and regulations concerning showing of colts and stallions. **Classes 1, 6 & 29 Qualify**

BSPS BRIGHT STARS PERFORMANCE SUPREME 2014 Open to BSPS MEMBERS and NON MEMBERS with registered or unregistered animals. The 1st 2nds and 3rd placed ponies in each class will qualify for the final to be held at the 2014 BSPS Championships Show. QUALIFICATION CARDS WILL BE AWARDED TO THE FIRST THREE ANIMALS IN EACH CLASS

CHAPS

"This show is affiliated to The Coloured Horse & Pony Society (UK). Both owner and the rider/exhibitor need not be a member of CHAPS (UK) nor must the horse or pony be registered with CHAPS (UK) to compete. **The CHAPS (UK) Championship Show will be held on 28th -30th Aug 2014 . Shows held on or after date of Championship Show will count as 2015 qualifiers. Members to apply in writing to CHAPS (UK) for appropriate qualifier card.**

The following classes are CHAPS (UK) Qualifiers [1,8,9,12,18,20,21,37,39]. For full rulings and information on competition/qualification, please refer to the CHAPS (UK) Members' Handbook; or visit www.chapsuk.com for rulings. All stallions entering these classes must be graded with CHAPS (UK). - please note it is important that judges must sign all qualification cards in the ring at the time of competition. *It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to obtain from CHAPS (UK) Admin, and to carry, their Qualification and Membership Cards.* Qualification is presented as stated above BUT a horse/pony may only qualify once per season for each Final it is eligible for.

Amateur Showing 1st -3rd qualify for the amateur showing society national championships. Full details can be found on www.amateurshowingsociety.co.uk or telephone 01284 388923. Competitors have 28 days to become a member to retain the qualification.

BEAVER HALL RULES

- Competitors **do not** have to be a Beaver Hall Member to compete at this event. Only Beaver Hall Members will be eligible for The Beaver Hall Challenge Cups to be awarded at the Beaver Hall Championships 14th-15th Sept 2014.
