Class 1 Team & Individual County Qualifier Prelim 14 (2006) – for all riders

Teams of 3 or 4, best 3 scores to count.

All team riders also automatically count for individual placings

The County Dressage Team and Individual Prelim series is open to horse & rider combinations that have not competed at British Dressage Elementary level or above and is open to horse & rider combinations with 21 BD points or less, gained together at novice level. Therefore, horse & rider combinations may compete at BD bronze prelim and silver prelim level and may have gained prelim points.

Class 2 Novice 27 (2007) – individual county qualifier only.

The County Dressage Individual Novice series is open to riders not to have competed at BD Medium level or above or BE Intermediate level and horses with 49BD points or less (gained at BD Novice level or above).

This competition is open to schools from all counties and will count for RPL points
