Stallion, mare, colt, filly or gelding, any age. This class may be divided as appropriate.

**EQUIFEST OPEN RIDDEN MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND** Open to Mountain & Moorland ponies registered with their respective Pure Bred Societies of Connemara, Dales, Dartmoor, Exmoor, Fell, Highland, New Forest, Shetland, Welsh A, B, C and D. Stallion, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over. Rider any age. This class may be divided as appropriate

Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 128cms. Riders not to have attained their 9<sup>th</sup> birthday before 1st January in the current year. To be led by an attendant and shown in a Snaffle Bridle, the lead rein to be attached to the noseband only.

**EQUIFEST MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND FIRST RIDDEN** Open to Mountain & Moorland ponies, registered with their respective Pure Bred Societies of Dartmoor, Exmoor, New Forest, Shetland, and Welsh A or B. Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not

exceeding 128cms. Riders not to have attained their 12th birthday before 1st January in the current year. To be shown in any suitable bridle.

Riders not to have attained their 17th birthday before the 1st January in the current year. Riders not to have attained their 13th birthday before 1st January in the current year. • Show Pony, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, exceeding 128cms but not exceeding 138cms. Riders not to have attained their 15th birthday before 1st January in the current year. • Show Pony, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, exceeding 138cms but not exceeding 148cms. Riders not to have attained their 17th birthday before 1st January in the current year.

**THE COLES SHOW TEAM / EQUIFEST SHOW PONY FIRST RIDDEN** First Ridden Pony, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 128cm. Riders not to have attained their 10th birthday before 1st January in the current year. To be shown in any suitable bridle.

EQUIFEST RIDDEN SHOW HUNTER PONIES Show Hunter Pony, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 153cms. Riders not to have attained their 20th birthday before the 1st January in the current year. Classes may be divided as follows: • Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 122cms. Riders not to have attained their 12th birthday before 1st January in the current year. • Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, exceeding 122cms but not exceeding 133cms. Riders not to have attained their 14th birthday before 1st January in the current year • Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, exceeding 133cms but not exceeding 143cms. Riders not to have attained their 17th birthday before 1st January in the current year. • Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, exceeding 143cms but not exceeding 153cms. Riders not to have attained their 20th birthday before 1st January in the current year.

Riders not to have attained their 25th birthday before 1st January in the current year. Classes may be divided as follows: • Open Intermediate Show Riding Type, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, exceeding 146cms but not exceeding 153cms. Riders not to have attained their 25th birthday before 1st January in the current year. • Open Intermediate Show Riding Type, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, exceeding 153cms but not exceeding 158cms. Riders not to have attained their 25th birthday before 1st January in the current year.

Classes may be divided as follows: • Small Riding Horses - mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, exceeding 148cms but not exceeding 158cms. Riders any age. • Large Riding Horses - mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, exceeding 158cms. Riders any age.

**NUPAFED / EQUIFEST RIDDEN COBS** Open Ridden Cob, mare or gelding, 4 years old & over, exceeding 148cms but not exceeding 155cms. Riders any age. Classes may be divided as follows: • Open Lightweight Ridden Cob, mare or gelding, exceeding 148cms but not exceeding 155cms. • Open Heavyweight Ridden Cob, mare or gelding, exceeding 148cms but not exceeding 155cms.

**EQUIFEST MAXI COBS** Open Maxi Cobs, mare or gelding 4 years old and over, exceeding 155cms – to be judged as Cobs. Riders any age.

**BLACK COUNTRY SADDLES / EQUIFEST RIDDEN HUNTERS** Open Ridden Hunter, mare or gelding, 4 years old & over, exceeding 153cms. Riders any age. Classes may be divided as follows: • Lightweight Hunter, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, capable of carrying up to 12.7 stone. • Middleweight Hunter, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, capable of carrying 12.7 stone but not 14 stone. • Heavyweight Hunter, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over capable of carrying of carrying over 14st.

For In-Hand Classes- Minimum age of handler = 11 years old. First Ridden ponies/riders will be asked after the initial walk round to come into the centre of the ring. First Ridden Competitors will only canter in their individual shows. Lead Rein Riders: If a strip section is required a lead rein rider MUST stay mounted.

STALLIONS- Either for In Hand or Ridden classes, Competitors Must be 16 years of age or over. Competitors cannot enter the ring once the command of trot has been given. The same rider/handler/pony/horse combination must stay the same from qualifier to grand final.

### **STARS (Applies to Beaver Hall Members only)**

Qualification will be taken from points accrued over the season which give rise to our champion, Reserve or 2<sup>nd</sup> Reserve for each relevant class across the season. The first option of representing Beaver Hall will be offered to our Champion of each relevant Stars qualifying class. If unable to attend the place will be offered to the Reserve: followed by the 2<sup>nd</sup> Reserve. Only these exhibitors/animals are eligible for qualification.

**TSR NAF FIVE STAR Showing Finals** – This show is a qualifier for the 2022 TSR NAF FIVE STAR Showing Finals. Qualify and enter ANY of the Finals Central, East Anglia, North West, North East, South East, South, Wales & South West or Scottish. You Do Not have to be a TSR member to qualify or enter a final. The Rider/Handler qualifies and can enter any horse/pony in any number of Finals!

TSR NAF FIVE STAR Riders Finals – 1st & 2nd riders qualify and will receive a qualification flyer in the ring.

TSR NAF FIVE STAR In Hand Finals – The two highest placed Handlers with a TSR In Hand Flyer will qualify in any In Hand class. Handlers MUST have their flyers signed in the ring by the judge/steward, cards are available FREE from the TSR website. Full details at <https://www.theshowingregister.co.uk/>

TSR Medal Awards – TSR members can collect qualification flyers & signatures and redeem for a TSR Medal see TSR website for details.

BSHA Intro Champs – With a TSR qualification card you can also enter the BSHA INTRO Champs in Sept at Addington Equestrian Centre – See [www.britishshowhorse.org](http://www.britishshowhorse.org) for more info & eligibility.

### **CHAPS**

This show is affiliated to The Coloured Horse & Pony Society (UK). Affiliation No.

Both owner and the rider/exhibitor need not be a member of CHAPS (UK) nor must the horse or pony be registered with CHAPS (UK) to compete. However in order to Qualify both Owner and Rider/Exhibitor need to be a current showing member. Members to apply in writing to CHAPS (UK) for appropriate qualifier card.

The CHAPS (UK) Championship Show will be held on 11th-13th August 2022. Shows held on or after the 7th August 2022 will count as 2022 qualifiers

All Stallions, 4 years old and over must be graded with CHAPS UK in order to compete in these classes and must wear their CHAPS UK Stallion Disc without exception.

Concours D' Elegance of Great Britain First, second and third placed horses/ponies not already qualified in eligible classes will qualify for the Champion of Britain Title classes to be held at Arena UK, Grantham on Sunday 4th September 2022. If a horse/pony has already qualified, cards may be handed down to 6th place at judge's discretion. Each qualified horse/pony will receive a qualification card in the ring which will enable the owner to enter the Championship Show, provided the owner and rider/handler are, or become registered with the Concours d'Elegance Society within 21 days of the qualifying show. ## **Rules**

1. Full and correct attire must be worn by all competitors and their grooms. All riders must wear correctly fitting headgear to PAS015 or higher, whilst mounted anywhere on the Showground. Junior members are also compelled to wear them when competing in hand. Grooms must wear suitable hats whilst attending in the ring. All forms of safety and rider protection are encouraged and as such back protectors are accepted at all events.

2. There must be no galloping or cantering unless in a collecting or judging ring.

3. Misuse of whips or spurs will not be tolerated under any circumstances. NO spurs are allowed in any mountain & moorland classes, juniors may also not wear spurs in Showing Classes. Maximum length of whip – 30 inches/75cms except in Dressage Classes.
4. It is the responsibility of the Competitor to ensure they are aware of the status of the rings and attend their booked in classes. No refund or transfer of classes.
5. No horse or pony under 4 years of age may be ridden on the showground.
6. Stallions and Colts may not be ridden or led by juniors who have not attained their 14th birthday in the current year. Any animal not kept sufficiently under control will be asked to leave the showground immediately by any Judge, Steward or Official of the Beaver Hall. Stallion owners are reminded that it is forbidden to run out their exhibit along the horse-box lines.
7. Dogs must be kept on leads and under control at all times.
8. Do not muck out your horsebox or trailer on the showground,
9. Fall of horse or rider in any class requires that the horse/pony is to be led from the ring.
10. Entries accepted on the day are non-refundable; Entries fees paid online in advance are refundable within 7 days of the event or on cancellation of the event by Beaver Hall.
11. Beaver Hall reserve the right to refuse membership and entries.
12. Beaver Hall reserve the right to cancel or amalgamate classes in the event of insufficient entries.
13. Beaver Hall reserve the right to change times or order of classes from those published.
- 14 ALL COMPETITORS will be deemed to have read and accepted these rules as a condition of their participation at Beaver Hall.
15. Please can you all take you litter home with you and leave the showground as you would expect to find it.
16. FLU VACCINATION AND HORSE PASSPORTS - All Horses and Ponies attending any events must be in possession of a valid Horse Passport and Vaccination Record. The vaccination record must show that the Horse or Pony has had the Flu booster within 12 months of the show date or had the first 2 flu vaccination prior to the show. The club reserves the right to check passports at any time and evict any animal which does not have a valid passport or vaccination card.
