## **Affiliations**

**Equifest** (All shows up to 31<sup>st</sup> July 2024)

This Show is affiliated to Equifest, taking place at the Arena UK, Grantham, Lincolnshire on the 1st – 4th August 2024. The two highest exhibits not already qualified in each affiliated class will qualify." Competitors may qualify for Equifest up to the end of July and can enter any championship class that they qualified for between the 12th July – 31st July at Equifest as long as they have their signed and dated Equifest Qualification card.

# STARS (Applies to Beaver Hall Members only) Must have attended 3 shows during the season.

Qualification will be taken from points accrued over the season which give rise to our champion, Reserve or 2<sup>nd</sup> Reserve for each relevant class across the season. The first option of representing Beaver Hall will be offered to our Champion of each relevant Stars qualifying class. If unable to attend the place will be offered to the Reserve: followed by the 2<sup>nd</sup> Reserve. Only these exhibitors/animals are eligible for qualification.

# **Concours d'Elegance**

First, second and third placed horses/ponies not already qualified in eligible classes will qualify for the Champion of Britain Title classes to be held at Onley Equestrian Centre, Rugby, Warwickshire on Saturday 24th & Sunday 25th August 2024. If a horse/pony has already qualified, cards may be handed down to 6th place at judge's discretion. Each qualified horse/pony will receive a qualification card in the ring which will enable the owner to enter the Championship Show, provided the owner and rider/handler are, or become registered with the Concours d'Elegance Society within 21 days of the qualifying show. ## Veteran Horse Society - AREA QUALIFIER 2024.

First round qualifier for the Veteran Horse Society Supreme Final: VETERAN HORSE OF THE YEAR 2024 Kindly Sponsored by Allen & Page.

Open to members and non-members. All competitors and grooms must adhere to VHS Rules in all circumstances. Failure to do so may result in immediate disqualification.

**VHS Regional Final qualification**. All competitors placed 1<sup>st</sup> to 4<sup>th</sup> in each age category will qualify for the corresponding class at VHS Regional Finals. Members must carry their cards in the ring and have their showing card signed by the judge in the ring as proof of qualification. Non-members will receive a red qualification card which can be exchanged for signed showing card when applying for VHS membership. *This MUST be done within 21 days of qualification.* It is the competitors' responsibility to present their Showing card to the judge.

Those wishing to join or renew with the Society will need to apply for this before  $1^{st}$  April each year or a late penalty fee of £15 will be charged.

#### Regional Finals are open to members only.

All competitors are eligible to enter open classes at the National Veteran Championships, to be held at Arena UK, Lincolnshire on 30<sup>th</sup> August – 1<sup>st</sup> September 2024. No qualification or membership necessary. See VHS website for schedule which is available mid-season 2024.

#### **Sunshine Tour**

This show is a qualifier for The Sunshine Tour Championships held at The All-England Showground, Hickstead from Thursday 12<sup>th</sup> – Sunday 15<sup>th</sup> September 2024. The Championships are for unaffiliated and amateur competitors in Dressage from Intro to Elementary, Show Jumping from Lead Rein to 1.0m; Showing for lead rein, in-hand, ridden, working hunter, veterans, plus many more

Qualification: Dressage & Show Jumping  $1^{st} - 3^{rd}$  place; Showing  $1^{st} - 4^{th}$  place. Qualification does not pass down the line. Qualifying competitions are held between 1st January and 31st July 2024

Registration of qualification must be completed within 1 month of competition (sooner for late July shows). Restrictions apply to both horse and competitor's previous winnings and amateur status, please check the website for Terms & Conditions.

#### **Rules**

- 1. Full and correct attire must be worn by all competitors and their grooms. All riders must wear correctly fitting headgear to PAS015 or higher, whilst mounted anywhere on the Showground. Junior members are also compelled to wear them when competing in hand. Grooms must wear suitable hats whilst attending in the ring.All forms of safety and rider protection are encouraged and as such back protectors are accepted at all events.
- 2. There must be no galloping or cantering unless in a collecting or judging ring.
- 3. Misuse of whips or spurs will not be tolerated under any circumstances. NO spurs are allowed in any mountain & moorland classes, juniors may also not wear spurs in Showing Classes. Maximum length of whip 30 inches/75cms except in Dressage Classes.
- 4. It is the responsibility of the Competitor to ensure they are aware of the status of the rings and attend their booked in classes. No refund or transfer of classes.
- 5. No horse or pony under 4 years of age may be ridden on the showground.
- 6. Stallions and Colts may not be ridden or led by juniors who have not attained their 14th birthday in the current year. Any animal not kept sufficiently under control will be asked to leave the showground immediately by any Judge, Steward or Official of the Beaver Hall. Stallion owners are reminded that it is forbidden to run out their exhibit along the horse-box lines.
- 7. Dogs must be kept on leads and under control at all times.
- 8. Do not muck out your horsebox or trailer on the showground,
- 9. Fall of horse or rider in any class requires that the horse/pony is to be led from the ring.
- 10. Entries accepted on the day are non-refundable; Entries fees paid online in advance are refundable within 7 days of the event or on cancellation of the event by Beaver Hall.
- 11. Beaver Hall reserve the right to refuse membership and entries.
- 12. Beaver Hall reserve the right to cancel or amalgamate classes in the event of insufficient entries.

- 13. Beaver Hall reserve the right to change times or order of classes from those published.
- 14 ALL COMPETITORS will be deemed to have read and accepted these rules as a condition of their participation at Beaver Hall.
- 15. Please can you all take you litter home with you and leave the showground as you would expect to find it.
- 16. FLU VACCINATION AND HORSE PASSPORTS All Horses and Ponies attending any events must be in possession of a valid Horse Passport and Vaccination Record. The vaccination record must show that the Horse or Pony has had the Flu booster within 12 months of the show date or had the first 2 flu vaccination prior to the show. The club reserves the right to check passports at any time and evict any animal which does not have a valid passport or vaccination card.
