1	<b>Young stock yearlings</b> , 2- or 3-years to be suitably bitted. Handler 16 years and over (Stars CHAPS ESUK)
2	<b>Best Condition</b> – In hand, open to all combinations ESUK
3	<b>In-hand M&amp;M Large Breeds</b> . Open to all M&M types: Fells, Dales, Highlands, New Forest, Welsh C and D Stars Trailblazers CHAPS ESUK EQUIFEST
4	<b>In-hand M&amp;M Small Breeds</b> Shetland, Section A and B, Exmoor, Dartmoor Stars CHAPS ESUK EQUIFEST
5	<b>In-hand Heavy &amp; Hairy</b> Open to draught horse types ESUK
6	<b>In-Hand Cob –Hogged or Hairy</b> If sufficient entries will split hogged/ hairy please state in notes which section EQUIFEST
7	<b>In Hand Veteran</b> Stars VHS Chaps, ESUK, EQUIFEST
8	<b>In-hand Coloured</b> Will split horse/ pony- native and non-native- please confirm in the notes section Stars Equifest Chaps ESUK
9	<b>In-Hand Palomino / Dun/ Roan/ Cream / Spotted</b> ESUK
10	<b>In-hand Hunter</b> open to hunter/type horse/pony ESUK will split
11	<b>In-hand Plaited Pony/Horse</b> Will be split if sufficient entries. To be shown plaited and trimmed. Stars ESUK
12	<b>Open Horse / Pony</b> split if sufficient entries Equifest ESUK

14	<b>Tiny Tots Handler</b> 4-7ys Handlers MUST be accompanied by an adult in the ring but the adult may not assist in the handling of the pony unless the handler is in difficulty. Stars ESUK
15	<b>Young Handler</b> 8-10yrs; horse or pony any height Stars ESUK
16	<b>Junior Handler</b> Handlers 11-16yrs horse or pony any height . Stars ESUK
17	<b>Lead Rein M&amp;M</b> Rider 9yrs & under; ponies not to exceed 128cms. Snaffle bridles only lead rein must be attached to the noseband only. Stars , Equifest ESUK
18	<b>Lead Rein Equitation</b> Rider 9yr & under. Snaffle bridles only. Lead rein to be attached directly between the noseband and the leader's hand only. Stars-ESUK
19	<b>Lead Rein show pony-show hunter pony</b> ponies 128cms & under riders 9ys & under Lead rein to be attached directly between the noseband and the leader's hand only ESUK
20	<b>Plaited Lead Rein Pony</b> Rider 9yr & under; ponies not to exceed 128cms. Snaffle bridles only lead rein attached to the nose band Stars ESUK EQUIFEST
21	<b>First Ridden Equitation incl Plaited</b> 10yrs & under. Snaffle bridles only. Stars ESUK
23	<b>M &amp; M First Ridden</b> ponies not to exceed 128cms. Any suitable bridle Stars Equifest ESUK
24	<b>Junior Equitation Rider</b> 11yrs-16yrs horse/pony any height. Snaffle bridles only. Stars ESUK
25	<b>Show Pony</b> 148cms & under Riders 16 yrs & under Stars ESUK EQUIFEST
26	<b>Show Hunter Pony</b> 153 cms & under Riders 18 yrs and & under Stars ESUK

33	<b>Working Hunter Nursery Stakes including Lead Rein</b> Riders 12yrs & under. Ponies not exc138cms. Lead reins permitted to be in snaffle & lead rein attached to nose band 20cms raised poles
34	<b>Very Novice WH</b> Riders any age aimed at very novice combinations & asks that people enter into the spirit intended. Jumps not to exceed 45 / 50cms No Spurs
35	<b>Mountain and Moorland WH</b> Working Hunter, Small Breeds. Small Breeds – Shetlands, Welsh Secon A and B, Dartmoor and Exmoor. Riders any age but suitable for height of exhibit. Jump height 60cms max. Stars
36	<b>Working Hunter Pony</b> 133cms and under. Rider any age, suitable for height of pony. Jump height 65cms max. Stars
37	<b>WH 65/70cms</b> Riders any age. Jumps 70cms max Equifest
38	<b>Mountain and Moorland Working Hunter, Large Breeds</b> Large Breeds – Dales, Fell, New Forest, Connemara, Highland, Welsh Secon C & D. Riders any age but suitable for height of exhibit. Jump height 70/75cms max.Stars
39	<b>Working Hunter, exceeding 153cms</b> Rider any age. Jump height 85/90cms max. Stars Equifest

40	<b>Beginners Showing</b> Open to combinations new to showing <b>NO</b> cantering snaffle bridles only open to real beginners any age rider.
41	<b>Novice Showing-</b> Open to Novice riders/horses walk & trot only in the go around, canter in the individual show only
42	<b>Ridden Best Turned Out</b> Open to any age rider, horse and pony. Stars

43	<b>Senior Equitation</b> Rider to have attained their 18 <sup>th</sup> birthday before 1 <sup>st</sup> January of the current year; pony any height. Snaffle bridles only. No spurs Stars
44	<b>Ridden M&amp;M</b> Will split Write in notes small or large Stars Equifest
45	<b>Riding Club Horse / Pony</b> Will split if sufficient entries Stars
46	<b>Ridden Show Horse/ Pony</b> Rider any age. Open to all plaited . Will be split if sufficient entries Stars
47	<b>Ridden Show Hunter Pony/ Horse</b> Rider any age. Open to all plaited hunter types. Stars Equifest
48	<b>Ridden Cob Write in notes hogged / hairy</b> Rider any age. Open to ALL ridden cobs, including Traditionals if sufficient entries will split, lightweight, heavy, maxi Stars : Equifest,
49	<b>Ridden Coloured</b> Rider any age. Open to all non-native/ native coloured horses and ponies will split Stars Trailblazers : Equifest Chaps
